Deposit

Enrollment in the SEEDlings at Mayapple summer camp is done by lottery basis, which will be drawn on April 1st. Any remaining spots available will be filled on a first come, first serve basis. A check of \$50 for each session is required in order to save your child's place, which will be deposited once your child's spot in the camp is confirmed. Deposited checks are not refundable. If your child does not win a spot in the camp, your check will be destroyed or returned. Please attach a check made out to "The Mayapple School at Loco Arts," and mail all forms to the above address. The remaining cost of the summer camp is due on the first day of summer camp, and is also payable by check.

Camp Rules and Regulations

- SEEDlings at Mayapple is an outdoor camp, and on most days campers will be
 outside for the entire session (minus bathroom breaks) rain or shine, excepting
 hazardous weather such as tornado, hurricane, hail, etc. Camp will not be cancelled
 due to rain, and campers must come prepared.
- All campers must come prepared with every item on this list:
 - Rain gear, such as rain jacket, rain pants, or rain suit, and rain boots, on every day, even if it is not forecasted to rain
 - Full change of clothing including shirt, shorts/pants, underwear, socks, and shoes
 - A wide brimmed hat, for keeping away gnats (even if your child says she does not like to wear hats)
 - o Water bottle filled with water only (no milk, Gatorade, soda, fruit juice, etc).
 - DO NOT pack: electronic devices, sunscreen, medicine, or any item that says "keep away from children" on its packaging. If you would like your child to wear sunscreen, please apply waterproof sunscreen ahead of time.
- All campers must wear closed toed shoes to camp, due to the increased risk of injury
 while wearing open toed shoes (altered gait, tripping, items becoming caught
 between toes and sole of sandal) compared to being barefoot or wearing closed toe
 shoes. Parents must inform camp counselors if they do not wish their child to go
 barefoot.
- Parents recognize that playing outside carries with it many rewards and certain risks not present while playing in a controlled indoor environment. Risks may include the presence of ticks, spiders, bees, and other insects, as well as hazardous plants such as poison ivy. Additionally, due to environmental degradation and natural factors, the health of the air, water, and land may pose risk to your child through smog, waterborne illnesses, presence of tetanus, or other factors. We make no promises to, nor do we have the ability to, remove these risks, and we will continue to play outside despite these risks. Additionally, children have access to

and are encouraged to play with their peers, and with natural materials such as sticks, stones, and sand, which could potentially result in normal childhood bumps, bruises, and irritations. Camp counselors will model and encourage non-hazardous ways of playing, and parents will be informed at the end of the morning of minor injuries and immediately of major injuries.

- Camp counselors will make every effort to provide a quality program for your child.
 Therefore, this list of rules and regulations may be augmented during the summer
 camp by teacher requests of you and your family, in order to maintain program
 integrity. We expect families to maintain open and honest communication about
 their child's needs and developmental stages.
- Snack is provided. Please do not send your child with a snack unless prearranged with Mayapple staff.

Parental Waiver: As parent/guardian of participant(s), permission is granted to engage in the Mayapple School at LoCo Arts After School program. I understand there are risks of physical injury to the participant(s). Considering all possible risks, on behalf of the participant(s) and myself, I voluntarily waive, release, discharge, and hold harmless the organization LoCo Arts, its employees, supervisors, appointed officials, agents, representatives and volunteers from all claims for all injuries to participant(s), no matter how severe.
